Your Prep Work

- Create a list of must-have features and your wish list.

 - Take rough measurements and photos of your existing bathroom.

1st Design Appointment

- Review your floor plan and layout options.
 - Discuss plans & options for the tub and/or shower.
 - Decide on flooring: keep or replace?
 - Plan the project timeline.
- Select your vanity
 - Wood species, door style and finishes.
 - Choose a cabinetry line (essential to begin design).
 - Explore built-in storage.
 - Pick countertop materials.
 - Discuss accessories like moldings and accents.
 - Select faucets, flooring, tile, and hardware.
 - Get our list of preferred local contractors for installation.
 - Schedule a professional measure.

2nd Design Appointment

- Review the updated design, including floor plans and visuals.

 - Make adjustments as needed.
